victims of more than \$5 million, and this scheme took 1 2 place over 2-and-a-half years. You were convicted by a 3 jury of all counts in the Indictment in which you were 4 named. And although you maintain that you are innocent, 5 you don't deny that you and the defendants did receive 6 this \$5 million from these victim companies and that you 7 have not repaid it. 8 And your defense is that this is a civil contract 9 matter, and you all have been persecuted because it is a 10 black company, yet you haven't bothered to repay it, and 11 it wasn't just a civil matter. If it had been one company 12 or two, it might have been a civil matter. But the fact 13 that it was 42 companies over a 2-and-a-half-year period, 14 involving \$5 million in which false statements were made, made it a fraudulent scheme. 15 16 A jury heard your arguments, they heard the 17 evidence, and they disagreed with you. Now, what is 18 really sad to me is that you are a bright, intelligent 19 man, as were your co-defendants. And instead of using 20 your God-given talents to advance yourself legally, as you 21 had done up to the point that you got involved with this group, you chose to use those talents in a way that was 22 23 fraudulent and criminal, and in a way that severely hurt 24 financially the 42 victim companies that you defrauded.
